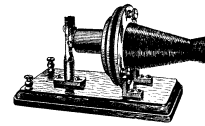
STEEL (1856)
 Bessemer Process



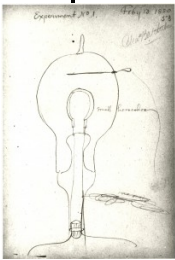

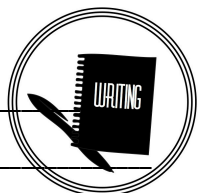

INVENTION THESIS (answer the question – Which invention had the biggest impact?):



MAIN CLAIM/THESIS:
 \ statement that asserts
 he writer's position on
 he given prompt or
 question

INCOMPLETE
 0 points

__ The author offers no identifiable thesis.

EMERGING
 1 points

__ In a single sentence
 __ at the end of the introduction
 __ the author responds to the prompt / question.

MODERATE
 2 points

The thesis is
 __ clearly written and
 __ asserts an opinion that requires further support (doesn't simply restate the prompt).

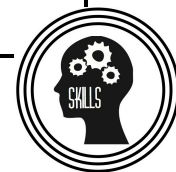
EFFECTIVE
 3 points

__ The thesis addresses the fullness of the question or prompt (e.g. responds to all parts of a multi-part question).

EXCELLENT
 4 points

__ The author further focuses the thesis (e.g. announces sub-claims by introducing paragraph topics, offers a road map, etc.).

GRANT ME A PATENT ACTIVITY



Instructions:

1. Pick an invention from Mrs. Holt or Mr. Bird – which one is your teacher? Which one?
2. Research information about the invention
3. Create an advertisement that persuades the patent office to grant a patent to your invention
 - a. Use the entire back side of this paper
 - b. Include the name of the invention
 - c. Draw a good, detailed picture of the invention
 - d. Explain at least 3 pieces of evidence as to why this is a good invention
